

REMOTE PILOT VIRTUAL TEST PREP

Quick Start Guide

The best way to study for the FAA Knowledge Exam is simply to follow this course as presented in *Virtual Test Prep*, completing each lesson in the order given.

- Read: (Recommended, not required): Begin by reading a lesson in The Complete Remote Pilot by Bob Gardner and David Ison (sold separately). This is the recommended companion textbook that can serve as the foundation to the required aeronautical knowledge.
- **2. Watch:** Upon completion of each textbook lesson, move on to the same video in *Virtual Test Prep* for an instructional presentation of the subject matter.
- **3. Study:** After completing a DVD lesson, open ASA *Prepware* software to review and answer the questions for that subject, using STUDY mode.
- **4. Repeat:** Conduct steps 1–4 for all of the lessons in the course.
- **5. Practice:** When you have finished all the lessons, use *Prepware* to take practice exams. Upon successful completion of 2 practice tests, each with a score of 80% or better, you are ready to take your official FAA Knowledge Exam at a testing center.

Prepware Installation

Visit **asa2fly.com/prepnow** to download the current installer package for your type of computer, Windows or Macintosh. Follow the instructions listed at PrepNow to download, install and activate your software using the 25-digit code found below

When the installation is complete, start the program using the Prepware icon on your desktop or Windows computer. To start *Prepware* on a Macintosh computer, open a new Finder window and select the Applications folder. Inside Applications you will find a listing for Prepware.
