

Update to

Airline Transport Pilot and Type Rating — Airplane And Aircraft Dispatcher Practical Test Standards (ASA-8081-5F.7)

This Update makes the Aircraft Dispatcher (FAA-S-8081-10D) Practical Test Standards current for all regulatory and procedural changes including, Change 1 (11/7/13), Change 2 (9/22/17), and Change 3 (1/8/18).

Change 1 (11/7/2013)

• Page 3, added the below 14 CFR part 117 to reference list in Practical Test Book Description section of the Introduction. This regulation becomes effective on January 4, 2014.

14 CFR part 117 Flight and Duty Limitations and Rest Requirements: Flightcrew Members

• Page 20, added 14 CFR part 117 to references for Area of Operation II, Task B: Airports, Crew, and Company Procedures to read:

References: 14 CFR parts 117 and 121; General Operations

Manual, Operations Specifications, A/FD; En Route High/low Charts, Terminal Area Charts; SIDs.

Change 2 (9/22/2017)

- Page 7, removed "NOTAM Information" from the list of materials to be supplied by the applicant in the Equipment and Documents Required for the Practical Test section of the Introduction.
- Page 8, added the below note regarding restriction of the use of electronic devices by an applicant during the practical test to the Equipment and Documents Required for the Practical Test section of the Introduction.

NOTE: Applicant use of devices with an internet connection and/or communication capability is strictly prohibited during testing.

• Page 9, removed note from Examiner Responsibility section of the Introduction, as equipment and documents required for the practical test are addressed in the Equipment and Documents Required for the Practical Test section of the Introduction.

Change 3 (1/8/2018)

- Page 7, updated reference to location of information in FAA Order 8900.1 regarding applicants under 23 years of age in the Aircraft Dispatcher Certification Prerequisites section of the Introduction to read:
 - a. Applicants under 23 years of age that pass the practical test will receive a letter of aeronautical competency in accordance with FAA Order 8900.1 volume 5, chapter 5, section 10.
- Page 7, updated list of 14 CFR parts to be supplied by the applicant in the Equipment and Documents Required for the Practical Test section of the Introduction to include the following parts 117 and 120 to read:
 - 14. Computer and Plotter;
 - 15. 14 CFR parts 1, 25, 61, 65 Subpart C, 71, 91, 110, 117, 119, 120, 121, and 139;
